St Benedict - Patron of Europe

Born at Norcia in Umbria (Italy) about the year 480. After studying at Rome, he led a life of solitude in Subiaco and gathered disciples around him, and then went to Monte Cassino. Here he founded a well-known monastery and wrote his 'Rule', as a result of which he has been called the Father of Monasticism in the West. He died on 21st March 547 but from the end of the eighth century he has been venerated on 11th July in many places. On the feast day of St Benedict we pray for all who have responded to God's call to live a monastic life of prayer and devotion. Of course we pray especially for Brother John and community of the Monastery of Christ our
